February: 18-hours of prayer.
 Teen Challenge welcome and support (Christ-centered substance abuse treatment).
 Easter Passion Play (people helping, lives changed).
 Kenya/Uganda Mission Trip (nine people; visits to schools, slums, homes, churches and a prison; sharing Bibles, shoes, school supplies, balls, prayers, the Good News and ourselves among four separate tribes, often to the *least of these*. Since then you provided a home for a widow and her children, over 200 Bibles for a church and prison and food for dozens of starving people.)
 Volunteering to fight the flood by sandbagging, moving furniture, serving food, etc.
 Assistance through Salvation Army by volunteering, providing food and giving money.
 Largest worship attendance and giving ever at TBC.
 Beginning of new building, work and provision during difficult weather, more funds raised.
 Encouraging college students interested in missions (3 TBCers) and discipleship (TCX and other conferences).
 Providing for a TBCer considering mission aviation.
 Christmas gifts for 20 children on the angel tree (locally) and over 50 children in third world countries (Operation Christmas Child).
 Encouraging another TBCer to prepare for future ministry through Sioux Falls Seminary
 Beginning *Friends for Life* ministry to moms in need.
 24 NDSH residents receiving or rededicating their lives to Jesus Christ . . . through worship.
 Rummage sale proceeds providing a cleft palate and lip surgery for a child in China.
 Welcome and generosity to TBC missionaries serving in Cameroon and Japan.
 Two TBC families adopting international children. Another family in process.
 Visits, caroling, moving, providing food & transportation.
