Judges 9 (*Life Stranger Than Fiction #5*)

"We will serve the LORD our God and obey him." Joshua 24:24

- ◆ How do I handle power and position?

Also a dispute arose among them as to which of them was considered to be greatest. Jesus said to them, "The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them; and those who exercise authority over them call themselves Benefactors. But you are not to be like that. Instead, the greatest among you should be like the youngest, and the one who rules like the one who serves. For who is greater, the one who is at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who is at the table? But I am among you as one who serves." Luke 22:24-27 (cf. Matthew 20:28)

- ◆ How do I treat people?

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:3-5 (cf. 2:1-2; Galatians 5:16-26; Ephesians 4:22-5:21; Colossians 3:12-17; 1 Corinthians 12; Ephesians 4)

- ◆ What do I do with praise?

Not to us, O LORD, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness. Psalm 115:1

Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven. Matthew 6:16
