Vocation: Larry is the founder and director of Christian Mission Aid (CMA). Debbie is the administrator and co-founder. CMA consists of Christian outreach ministries, development, aid and relief. The foundation of their work is Jesus Christ and Him crucified (1 Corinthians 2:2).

Hobbies: Although CMA occupies much of their life and ministry, Larry & Debbie also enjoy camping—African style! Debbie enjoys reading and Larry likes to go fishing.

Spiritual Background: Larry was raised as a Catholic; Debbie's family considered themselves Methodists, but did not attend church. Both Debbie and Larry were searching for Truth, and each found Jesus Christ through separate Bible studies. Both were also greatly influenced by author Hal Lindsey. In 1980—within three months of their salvation in Christ and wanting to "do something with their lives" and having a strong desire to go to Africa—they went to work in the refugee camps in Somalia with International Christian Aid. Because they had been part of a Baptist church in Nairobi and because they desired a church home in the U.S., they visited TBC (having heard about it), liked it and joined our TBC fellowship several years ago.
