SUFFERING → REJOICING

Acts 2:22-36; Psalm 16:8-11 (Necessary Suffering #7)

"What sign do you show us for doing these things?" Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."
John 2:18-19 (cf. vss. 20-22; Luke 24:44-47)

We rejoice in this Resurrection Day because . . .

- ◆ God's plan is accomplished . . . as He said.

This Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. Acts 2:23

- ◆ God raised Messiah Jesus . . . as He said.

God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it. Acts 2:24 (cf. vss. 22-36, 41; Psalm 16:8-11)

- ◆ God will raise us . . . as He said. (cf. 1 Cor. 15:1-8)

. . . knowing that he who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus and bring us with you into his presence. 2 Corinthians 4:14

He (God) raised us up with him (Christ) and seated us with him (Christ) in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:6

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Colossians 3:1

The good news we receive saves us and is the foundation on which we stand.

Liberia - 45.3% Ethnic Religions; 16.7% Islam; 36.8% Christian
Liberia's greatest challenges include civil war recovery and the devastating effects of the ebola virus. Many people live in poverty and have little access to sanitation facilities. The Liberian church is often characterized as being scripturally ignorant and materialistic. Islam continues to spread; Christian converts are mistreated by fundamentalist Muslims in Liberia.
