AFGHANISTAN— Muslim 99.8%; Christian 0.05%

The country remains mired in chaos as it prepares for its 2014 presidential elections. Little progress has been made toward a peace agreement with the Taliban, which targets individuals for activities deemed un-Islamic. No formal churches exist in this country. Christians face intense persecution from family members and neighbors. The Taliban website released a warning (2011) stating that any Afghan suspected of converting to Christianity would be targeted for death. Since then, a Taliban blog has posted pictures of Christians being baptized, individual baptismal certificates and worship times.
