AROUND THE WORLD

Nepal - 82.3.7% Hinduism; 0.9% Christianity
 Christians frequently face attacks by Hindu extremists, and those found guilty of violating religious conversion laws face fines or prison sentences. Churches are often targeted by radical groups. Christian converts from Hinduism are beaten, forced out of their homes, and sometimes prevented from using public areas like wells. Many Nepalis are very poor, and Christians often have difficulty affording a Bible of their own.
