We are updating our list of college students and those entering the military for the 2018-2019 year. If you would like to be on the card ministry list, please get your address to the church office by the end of August.

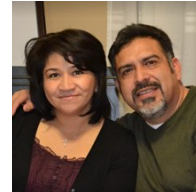

### **Antonio Lopez - Calgary, Alberta.**

## AROUND THE WORLD

### **Sri Lanka - 1.2% Evangelical Christian; 70.02% Buddhist**

The main drivers of persecution are radical Buddhist movements, at time supported by local officials. Converts from a Buddhist or Hindu background suffer the strongest forms of persecution. They are subject to harassment, discrimination, and marginalization by family and community. They are put under pressure to recant Christianity, as such conversion is regarded as betrayal. The Christian minority is partly tolerated, but converts to Christianity are not.
