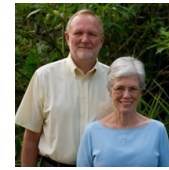

Laos - 57.2% Buddhism; 3.2% Christianity
 Laos, which is extremely rural, has plans to improve its poor economy through hydropower operations. Ruled by the Communist Party, all activities are monitored by the government. Although the constitution protects religious freedom, a decree requires Christians to register all activities. The government often prevents the construction of new churches as well as Christian funerals and holiday celebrations. Believers are frequently harassed, evicted from their homes, forcibly relocated, denied education, and arrested and charged with false accusations.
