Obeying the Lord . . .

- Will cost me/us.

“As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love. These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.”
John 15:9-11 ESV

- Lives by faith in His promises.

Be strong. I am with you. The covenant is still valid. My Spirit remains on you. Do not fear. (cf. 2:4b-5)

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.
John 1:14 ESV (cf. Hebrews 12:25-29)

- Opens the door for His blessing.

Around the World

***ERITREA** - Muslim 50.2%; Christian 47.3%

The Eritrean government has banned all Christian groups except for a few churches. With the exception of Sunni Islam, all other public religious practice has been banned. Security forces disrupt private worship, conduct mass arrests at prayer meetings and detain those arrested for indefinite periods. Prisoners are tortured and subjected to extremely poor living conditions, often locked in metal shipping containers and underground bunkers.
