## THE KING IS COMING!

Zechariah (*Minor Faith, Major Problems* #11)

- ◆ Prepare a place for the King.

Eight visions (chapters 1-6). Central part: chapters 3 & 4.

*"This is what the LORD Almighty says, 'Administer true justice; show mercy and compassion to one another. Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless, the alien or the poor. In your hearts do not think evil of each other.'" 7:9-10*

*"So now I have determined to do good again to Jerusalem and Judah. Do not be afraid. These are the things you are to do: Speak the truth to each other, and render true and sound judgment in your courts; do not plot evil against your neighbor, and do not love to swear falsely. I hate all this," declares the LORD. 8:15-17*

- ◆ Prepare a people for the King.

Compare Zech. 9:9 (Mt. 21:5; Jn. 12:15) and 11:13 (Mt. 27:9-10).

*"I will strengthen them in the LORD and in his name they will walk," declares the LORD. 10:12*

- ◆ Prepare for a paradise when the King comes again.

Compare Zech. 12:10 (Jn. 19:34, 37) and 13:7 (Mt. 26:31; Mk. 14:27).

*The LORD will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one LORD, and his name the only name. 14:9 (cf. Philippians 2:1-11)*

**NEXT STEPS:** Spend some time in Zechariah and the outline this week. Go deeper by referencing the message online. How does knowing of the King's imminent return impact your life today? Is your response one of apathy? Disbelief? Trying to figure out His timetable? Walking with Him today? What impact do 7:9-10 and 8:15-17 have on your response? Spend some time with another person interacting and praying together.

### Around the World

\***ETHIOPIA** - Christian 60.7%; Muslim 34.1%

Although Ethiopia is a predominantly Christian nation, Christians in Muslim areas often experience mistreatment and discrimination. In some provinces Christian activities are severely restricted. Christians have been imprisoned and killed in these areas. In the past, members of the Ethiopian Orthodox Church have harassed evangelical Christians. The EOC'S influence reaches to government levels, and the state sometimes persecutes evangelicals.
