In high school, Kalen and his family became members of TBC, where he regularly attended youth group. Following his graduation from Jamestown College, he moved to Colorado, where he met Sarah at Denver Seminary. Kalen and Sarah were married in August of 2013 in Iowa. That same month, he began working as a pastoral intern at Garden Park Church in Denver - a small Mennonite church tucked away in a low-income, urban setting. After graduating with a Master of Divinity degree in May of 2014, Kalen and Sarah relocated to La Crosse, WI, where he worked as a chaplain intern at Gundersen Health System and received training in Clinical Pastoral Education. At the completion of his internship, Kalen and Sarah found God leading them to relocate to Jamestown. Since being back in North Dakota, he has had opportunities to preach regularly at First Baptist Church in Medina. He also fills in occasionally as a pulpit supply pastor at Grace Baptist Church in Gackle.

Sarah grew up in Cedar Rapids, IA, where she came to know Christ at Faith Lutheran Church. She attended Wartburg College (Waverly, IA) where she majored in Writing and minored in Social Welfare. After graduating from college, Sarah spent a year in the workforce before moving to Colorado to begin her studies at Denver Seminary. Throughout her time in Denver, she worked as an Executive Director for SPARK Outreach – a non-profit organization that aided the homeless population - and spent time as an intern therapist at a community counseling center. Sarah graduated with her Master of Arts in Clinical Mental Health Counseling from Denver Seminary in August of 2014. While living in Wisconsin, she worked as a Case Manager for a community action program, which provided her with many opportunities to serve others in practical ways. Since relocating to Jamestown, Sarah has worked as a Human Relations Counselor at James River Correctional Center.

In their free time, Kalen and Sarah like spending time together outdoors hiking, biking and fishing. They both also enjoy watching movies, reading and spending time with friends and family.
