The congregation met September 13, 1964 for their first worship service in what was, at that time, the Seventh Day Adventist Church (217 2<sup>nd</sup> St. SE, Jamestown—NE of the Jamestown Middle School).

The parsonage was built in 1965 with groundbreaking for the facility at 1545 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. NW on November 7, 1965. First services in that building were October 2, 1966.

We will do some celebrating,
