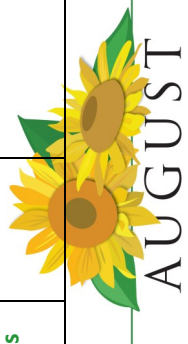

fact: "I the LORD do not change." It is not that God is uncaring or unconcerned. Precisely the opposite. He is consistent with His character and His words. "Return to me and I will return to you," says the LORD Almighty.

To a people undergoing difficulty because of their faith in Jesus, the writer of Hebrews reminds us: *Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.*

In the immediate context the writer quotes God's previous words (Deuteronomy 31:6; Psalm 118:6, 7): "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"

What practical difference does God's consistency have? The writer of Hebrews says it impacts how we regard marriage and sexual relationships, how we view and depend on money, how we treat and follow the words

and example of our leaders. **We don't live in the past. We live in the present with our confidence in the One Who is coming again, the One Who remains the same: past, present and future.**

The change God expects . . . is in you and me, a change that involves returning to Him, a change that anchors itself in the consistent promises of our Lord.

God knows that life is changing. Indeed, He is initiating some of it. Let's live in confidence before King Jesus and pray for His kingdom to come on earth as it is in heaven . . . beginning in our lives where we live each day. *We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure.*

Summer is almost over! Students and families will be trading in flip-flops and beach towels for books and long school days. It will be a fresh year full of new beginnings. For some, it will even mean going to a new school. This time of year is known for being a season of new beginnings or a fresh start.



Our Student Ministry will also have a new season. We will begin our second year of **Missional Leadership University**. The **Missional Leadership University (MLU)** is a two-year intensive leadership training experience for high school juniors and seniors, as well as any college students interested in learning the Biblical Fundamentals of *Leadership, Apologetics, Ethics, Evangelism, Missional Living and Developing a Biblical Worldview*. I am consulting with Josh McDowell, Sean McDowell, Andy Braner and Tim Elmore on curriculum development. The **MLU** meets weekly during the nine-month school year. Interested students **MUST** fill out a Leadership Application and have it returned by **August 15, 2015**. This leadership experience will include Biblical teaching, small group interaction and hands-on leadership opportunities. The **MLU** will be limited to 15 students. This is a great opportunity for our Student Ministry to invest in the next generation of leaders by giving them a mixture of fundamental teaching and real world experience.

This year we will be offering two different tracks. Track 1 is the Introduction Track, consisting of teaching and training. We will be looking at what it means to be a disciple. Track 1 combines both classroom time and projects in the community. Track 2 is a continuation for students who completed Track 1, launching them into areas of service. Based on their *S.H.A.P.E.*, students will be put in positions of leadership and service within our Student Ministry and Church.

Please pray for us as we continue on this journey of discovery. I cannot wait to see how God is going to use this ministry in the lives of our students and our church. God Bless and remember get out there and transform your world...
