***KYRGYZSTAN**— Muslim 88.7%; Christian 5.3%

Kyrgyzstan's laws promise to uphold religious freedom, but in practice these laws are not always followed. Believers regularly face property destruction, intimidation and physical harm. Religious groups are required to re-register for legal status, and churches must now include more than 200 adult Kyrgyz citizens (for legal recognition). Officials have said they will close churches in an effort to pacify the Muslim majority.
