Isaiah 53:1-3 (*Mission Implausible #2*)

◆ Unbelievable (53:1)

But not all (Israel) accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our message?" Consequently, faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the message of Christ. Romans 10:16, 17 (cf. John 12:38ff)

"I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand, I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles, to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness." Isaiah 42:6-7 (cf. 49:6; 51:9-10; 52:10; 63:12)

For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:18

◆ Unexpected (53:2a)

A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. Isaiah 11:1 (cf. 4:2)

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD. Isaiah 55:8

◆ Unremarkable (53:2b)

◆ Undesirable (53:3a)

As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him. 1 Peter 2:4

◆ Unwelcome (53:3b)

He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. John 1:10, 11 (cf. Matthew 16:21; 27:29)

Although he was a son, he learned obedience from what he suffered. Hebrews 5:8 (cf. 4:14-16)

NEXT STEPS: Read Isaiah 53:1-3 each day, spending time pondering the five words. Review the other passages. Share your thoughts and findings with another. Which of the five words stands out? How does God's plan differ from how the world acknowledges a hero? Spend some time praying together. Read Isaiah 53:4-6 before next Sunday and consider how you are bringing your best to worship the Lord.

Around the World

***KENYA** - 8% Muslim; 83% Christian

Pressing challenges for Kenya include high unemployment and poverty. Most Kenyans live below the poverty level (\$1/day). The country is also experiencing increased drug trafficking, expanding urban slums and growing populations of street children and AIDS orphans. Despite a declining infection rate, about 150 people still die of AIDS every day. Kenyans, by law, have freedom of religion, and nearly 50% identify themselves as evangelical Christians. Muslims are attempting to Islamize the coast and northwest areas (traditionally Muslim) and establish Shariah law. Muslims try to convert non-Muslims through financial inducements and violence. Converts from Islam to Christianity are subject to harassment, persecution and violence. Somali Islamic militants have committed acts of violence within Kenya's borders at an increasing rate. Terrorists have attacked churches in Kenya, killing pastors and other Christians, including children.
