Psalm 90; Revelation 20:11-21:8; 22:1-5 (*It's About Time* #9)

- ◆ Time is running out.

Read Romans 8:18-25.

- ◆ All will stand before the Timeless One.

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Then another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged by what was written in the books, according to what they had done. . . And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

- ◆ God will dwell with His people for all time.

Djibouti - 97.3% Islam; 1.8% Christianity
Islam is the official state religion of Djibouti. Three Christian groups are recognized by the government: French Protestant, Roman Catholic, and Ethiopian Orthodox. Citizens who express an interest in Christianity face the risk of persecution from families and friends. Muslims who convert to Christianity are generally isolated, beaten, and sometimes killed for abandoning Islam.
