Comoros is a poor, predominantly Muslim country with an unstable government. Christians cannot proselytize and usually suffer societal discrimination and pressure to conform to Islam. This intimidation keeps many people away from church, and the very few Christians who openly practice their faith do so in association with established groups such as the Catholic Church.
