February 2 we will begin a **message series**, examining the NAB Statement of Beliefs. We're calling it, ***This We Believe (TBC Basics)***. Each week we will look at the basic teachings we believe about the Bible, Trinity, the Father, Son, Holy Spirit, etc. **Small groups** will also be basing their studies on this series. Periodically we will take breaks from *This We Believe* to welcome guests or entertain a different focus. **Teen Challenge** will be with us Sunday, **February 9**.
