Around the World

***INDONESIA** - 80.3% Muslim; 15.9% Christian

Indonesia has a stable and robust democracy. It has the largest Muslim population and the fourth largest overall population. Indonesians may choose to follow any of five religions; in practice, however, Muslims receive preferential treatment. Christian groups have reported a surge in church attendance in recent years, a source of contention. Local governments have recently closed evangelical churches and imposed restrictions on church expansion. Extremists have forcibly closed churches, sometimes with the tacit approval of local officials and police. A 1969 decree, revised in 2006, stipulates that all religious groups must apply for permits to establish and operate places worship; in practice, only non-Muslims must comply. In addition, the decree states that a majority of neighbors in the area must agree to a church's existence.
