Mark 2:23-3:6 (Genesis 2:1-3) (It's About Time #4)

God's design for Sabbath is . . .

- ◆ Rooted in relationship, not restrictions.

*"Be still, and know that I am God."* Psalm 46:10a

*Let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath. These are a shadow of the things to come.* Colossians 3:16-17 (cf. Romans 14:5, 17; Galatians 4:10)

*"If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the LORD honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly, then you shall take delight in the LORD . . ."*

Isaiah 58:13-14a

- ◆ His gift of rest received . . . and shared.

*"Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."*

Matthew 11:28

List ways of celebrating Sabbath.

- ◆ To bring His healing (His *good*), beginning with our heart.

*And he said to the man with the withered hand, "Come here." And he said to them, "Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do harm, to save life or to kill?" But they were silent. And he looked around at them with anger, grieved at their hardness of heart, and said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." He stretched it out, and his hand was restored."* Mark 3:3-5

**NEXT STEPS:** Read Mark 2:23-3:6 several times aloud. What is God's word to you? Discuss with another the legalisms of keeping sabbath. How do we emphasize relationship, gift and healing? Share ideas about how to regularly practice a sabbath. Thank God for the gift of sabbath and pray for each other. Prepare for worship next week by reading Psalm 139 as we consider past, present and future from God's perspective.
