Around the World

***IRAQ** - 95.9% Muslim; 1.6% Christian

Iraq is a complicated mixture of severe persecution and increased freedom for believers and evangelism. Islamic extremists have targeted Christian leaders, churches and businesses. The Iraqi constitution guarantees "full religious rights of all individuals." Other laws, however, restrict the freedom to change religions. To register, a church must have 500 members and the approval of the Council of Iraqi Churches. Between 2003 and 2014, about half the Christian population fled the country. With the advance of IS into Iraq (2014), many of the remaining Christians have been displaced or have fled. When the Islamic State (IS) invaded Mosul, they issued an ultimatum to the estimated 35,000 Christians there, telling them to convert, pay a high tax, leave or be killed. Nearly all fled. In spite of persecution and hardship, many Iraqis are now uniquely open to the gospel.
