## TBC HEALTH ASSESSMENT

Three Key Health Indicators:

- ◆ Personal transformation.

*We, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit. 2 Corinthians 3:18 (cf. Matthew 5:14-16)*

*I appeal to you therefore, brothers (and sisters), to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:1-2, ESV (cf. 12:3-21; Galatians 4:19; 5:22-23; 2 Peter 1:3-11)*

How am I 1) measuring and 2) promoting personal transformation?

- ◆ Promoting Community.

*The body is a unit, though it is made up of many parts; and though all its parts are many, they form one body. . . If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it. Now y'all are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it. 1 Corinthians 12:12, 26-27*

How am I 1) measuring and 2) promoting authentic community?

- ◆ Practicing Mission.

What would happen if, instead of adding more things to our lives, we adjusted our priorities to reform them around authentic community on mission and then gathering weekly for training and celebration of what God is doing?

## Around the World

**\*INDIA** - 74.3% Hindu; 14% Muslim; 5.8% Christian  
India is a highly diverse country, with a multitude of languages, cultures and religions. Despite India's increasing presence in the global economy, the vast majority of the rural population remains impoverished. The Indian constitution guarantees freedom of religion, yet six of the 29 state governments have implemented laws forbidding "forcible conversions"; these laws, frequently used against Christians, make it illegal to convert someone "by force, fraud or allurements". Violators face jail terms and hefty fines. Violence against Christians continues in the form of Bible burnings, destruction of churches and other property, imprisonments, beatings and murders. Attackers are rarely charged.

**\*Conflicts and Needs: South Sudan, Iraq, Syria, Ukraine, Yemen**
