John 13:31-35 (TBC Health #5)

When we love each other as Jesus loves us . . .

- ◆ The cross becomes visible and Jesus receives the glory.

“And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with you before the world began.” John 17:5

But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander. 1 Peter 3:15-16

- ◆ Jesus' new command is demonstrated.

“This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you.” Luke 22:20b

“As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now abide in my love. If you keep my commands, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and abide in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete.” John 15:9-11

- ◆ Jesus is seen as the source and the standard.

It was just before the Passover Feast. Jesus knew that the time had come for him to leave this world and go to the Father. Having loved his own who were in the world he now showed them the full extent of his love. John 13:1

“I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.” John 13:15

Around the World

***ISRAEL** - 75.4% Jewish; 16.7% Muslim; 2.0% Christian
 More than 120,000 Christians live in Israel (17,000 Messianic Jewish believers and an estimated 8,000 Palestinian Arab evangelical believers). Government structures attempt to provide freedom of religious beliefs, although Sharia law is used in both the West Bank and in Gaza. Both Arab and Jewish believers are persecuted and harassed, sometimes violently. Muslim extremists periodically persecute Arab Christians, particularly those from Muslim backgrounds. Authorities have been known to tell Christian converts to leave their communities to avoid harassment and persecution. Although some churches meet openly in the West Bank, the situation for Arab Christians is more oppressive in rural villages of the West Bank and in Gaza. In Israel, the well-organized and well-funded ultra-orthodox Jewish group Yad L'Achim is dedicated to removing the witness of Christ from Israel. This group and others like it have at times resorted to violence and harassment of Messianic Jews, Christians and missionaries in recent years.
