***LIBYA** – Muslim 97.0%; Christian 2.6%

Libya has a limit of one church per denomination per city. Meetings of more than six people are illegal, though this is not enforced. Foreigners are free to worship as they please, but the evangelization of Libyans is prohibited. Most Libyans are Muslim and are indifferent to matters of faith. Christian literature enters the country only through secretive means.
