YOU, ME, WEEDS, WATER . . . AND JESUS

(God's Garden #3)

- Weeds are a constant reminder of sin's curse.

"Beat your breasts for the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vines and for the land of my people, a land overgrown with thorns and briars."

Isaiah 32:12-13 (cf. 5:5-6; Proverbs 24:31; Genesis 3:17-19; Is. 1:30)

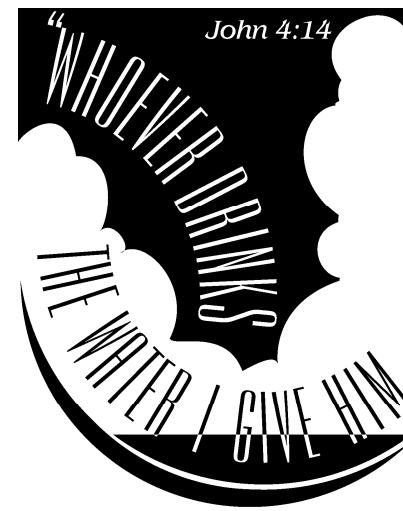
