Hebrews 10:19-25 (*But We See Jesus* #13)

Let us with confidence . . .

- Draw near to God. (10:22)

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. 4:16

List anything that may be causing you to hold back from drawing near to God with confidence.

- Hold fast to your hope in the One Who holds us. (10:23)

"No one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. I and the Father are one." John 10:28-30

What difference does it make knowing that God is faithful to His promise regarding holding you?

- Think about how we can stir up another to love and good works. (10:24-25)

NEXT STEPS: Read through the text several times aloud with another person. Share what word or phrase holds your attention. Read through or look up the other passages mentioned. Complete and share your responses to each point. Any habits that need adjusting regarding meeting with God's people? Share how someone *stirred you up to love and good works*. Where do you need encouragement? Talk about the *we* or *together* part. Pray for each other, thanking God that He is the basis for our confidence. Prepare for worship next Sunday by reading Hebrews 10:26-39.
