OUR MIDDLE MAN

Hebrews 9:15-28 (*But We See Jesus #11*)

Christ's death means . . .

- ◆ God's promise cannot be changed. (9:15-22)

Therefore he is the mediator of a new covenant, so that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance, since a death has occurred that redeems them from the transgressions committed under the first covenant.
9:15

But as it is (Christ) has obtained a ministry that is as much more excellent than the old as the covenant he mediates is better, since it is enacted on better promises. 8:6 (cf. 4:1, 6:12, 15, 17; 7:6; 8:8-12; Jeremiah 31:31-34)

What does the promise of eternal inheritance mean for you?

- ◆ He put away sin, appears before God's face and will come for those eagerly waiting for Him. (9:23-28)

He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself. And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment, so Christ, having been offered once to bear the sins of many, will appear a second time, not to deal with sin but to save those who are eagerly waiting for him. 9:26b-28

For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God . . . And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies . . . But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. Romans 8:19, 23, 25 (cf. 1 Corinthians 1:7; Philippians 3:20)

How would others say your life demonstrates an eager waiting for Christ's return or a dread of it?

NEXT STEPS: Read the text aloud several times with another, beginning with verse 14 (i. e. 9:14-28). Read the outline and other verses listed. Respond to the questions. Share what you are learning with each other. Have you trusted Christ alone for forgiveness of sins, so that you live as God's beloved child? Discuss what needs to change for you to live under His reign now. What is your next step? Pray for each other, praising God that Jesus Christ is our mediator, our One-in-the-middle.
