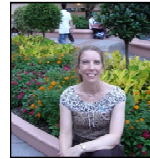

***COMOROS** Muslim 98.8%; Christian 0.9%

While the constitution guarantees religious freedom, Islam is the dominant religion, and evangelism is forbidden. Christians often face persecution from both the community and their own families. Christians of Comorian ethnicity face the greatest opposition. Only noncitizens may attend the two Catholic churches and one Protestant church in the country, and there are no official churches for Comorian people. In some areas, local authorities impose additional restrictions on the practice of Christianity.
