KNOWING ABOUT GOD OR KNOWING GOD?

Hebrews 8:1-13 (*But We See Jesus #9*)

Knowing God . . .

- ◆ Requires me to move from learning about to living for Him.

"For this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my laws into their minds, and write them on their hearts." 8:10a

Read Hebrews 1:3; Psalm 110:1; Exodus 25:40.

- ◆ Is about relationship rooted in identity.

"I will be their God, and they will be my people." 8:10b

And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God." Revelation 21:3 (cf. 2 Corinthians 6:16; 1 Peter 2:10)

- ◆ Is both personal and communal.

"And they shall not teach, each one his neighbor and each one his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest." 8:11

- ◆ Begins with God's mercy and His "poor" memory.

"For I will be merciful toward their iniquities, and I will remember their sins no more." 8:12 (cf. Psalm 103)

NEXT STEPS: Review the outline and scriptures listed (bonus: Jeremiah 31). Are there other passages that come to mind? Read through Hebrews 8 several times aloud with at least one other person. Share the word or phrase that draws your attention. Choose a verse to memorize. How is knowing God communal? Read or sing the old hymn, *My Sins Are Blotted Out, I Know!* What is God's next step for you? Who else would benefit from hearing what you've heard? Share in prayer for each other and in praise to God. Prepare for worship next week by reading Hebrews 9:1-14.

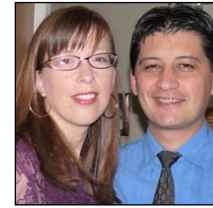
