IMAGE AND INTIMACY: FOUNDATION

Genesis 1-2

- ◆ 1:26-27 – God makes/creates us male and female in His image. *Male and female together display God's image more fully.*
- ◆ 1:28-29 – God blesses and gives us a charge to steward. *Ruling implies the responsibility of caring for what isn't ours.*
- ◆ 2:15-17 – God places the man in His garden to “serve and keep” it. *Work is to be an expression of worship.*
- ◆ 2:18-25 – God “builds” a woman, “a helper as opposite him,” in response to the aloneness of the man. *God's design for true intimacy involves opposites who live in the safety of “leaving” parents and “holding fast” to each other.*

Corollary: Any sexual relationship outside of one man and one woman in marriage cannot address our “aloneness”, nor does it affirm His image in us. Rather, this pseudo-sex illustrates the deception and willfulness of the first sin (Genesis 3), reinforcing the sexual obsession and gender confusion of our day.

The good news is that with Jesus' defeat of sin, death and Satan, we need no longer live enslaved or deceived by that obsession and confusion. Rather, **we are free to live in a relationship first with Christ, rediscovering God's image and design for intimacy.**

How do we relate to those who are not in Christ? We respectfully listen to them and demonstrate Biblical love. When we do share truth, it may be helpful to include sources other than the Bible, before they can acknowledge the One Who is THE Truth and listen to His word. Live and speak the good news (1 Peter 3:15-16).

How do we relate to those who claim to be in Christ, but are not following His word? Read Galatians 6:1-2. Also read 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, beginning with vs. 11. When they are open to hearing, bring them back to the foundation of image and intimacy (above). We must promote an intimacy with each other that does not include sex.
