Amos (Minor Faith, Major Problems #3)

♦ How do we sanctify the <u>worship</u> of wealth?

This is what the LORD says: "For three sins of Israel, even for four, I will not turn back (my wrath). They sell the righteous for silver, and the needy for a pair of sandals. They trample on the heads of the poor as upon the dust of the ground and deny justice to the oppressed. Father and son use the same girl and so profane my holy name. They lie down beside every altar on garments taken in pledge. In the house of their god they drink wine taken as fines." Amos 2:6-8 (cf. 7:9, 12-13; 4:4-5; 8:6)

Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life. 1 Timothy 6:17-19 (cf. vss. 6-10)

"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. . . No one can serve two masters . . . You cannot serve both God and Money." Matthew 6:21, 24

Where do we sell out the weak?

If you really keep the royal law found in Scripture, "Love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing right. But if you show favoritism, you sin and are convicted by the law as lawbreakers. . . Speak and act as those who are going to be judged by the law that gives freedom, because judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful. Mercy triumphs over judgment! James 2:8-9, 12-13

Let justice roll down like a river, righteousness like a never-failing steam! Amos 5:24 (cf. 3:14-4:1)

♦ When will we seek the Lord?

"Seek me and live," . . . Seek the LORD and live. . . Seek good, not evil, that you may live. Then the LORD God Almighty will be with you, just as you say he is. Amos 5:4b, 6, 14

"In that day I will restore David's fallen tent. I will repair its broken places, restore its ruins, and build it as it used to be, so that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations that bear my name," declares the LORD, who will do these things. Amos 9:11-12 (cf. Acts 15:16-17)

Now read through the book (a couple chapters each day) and respond to the questions again. What are your God-substitutes? How can you live out justice and righteousness where you live?
