THE OTHER SIDE OF BLESSING
 Obadiah (*Minor Faith, Major Problems #4*)

This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses. Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the LORD your God, listen to his voice, and hold fast to him. For the LORD is your life . . . Deuteronomy 30:19-20

◆ Edom's pride. (vss. 2-9)

Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18

◆ Edom's hatred. (vss. 10-14)

Remember, O LORD, what the Edomites did on the day Jerusalem fell. "Tear it down," they cried, "tear it down to its foundations!" Psalm 137:7

Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. Colossians 3:13 (cf. vss. 12-14; Ephesians 4:25-32; Matthew 18:15-17; Galatians 6:1-5)

◆ Edom's judgment. (vss. 15-21)

"I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse. And all nations will be blessed through you." Genesis 12:3

And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books . . . If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. Revelation 20:12, 15

And the kingdom will be the LORD's. Obadiah 21b (Philippians 2:10-11)

***CHIAPAS (MEXICO):** Folk Catholicism 64.5%; Christian (evangelical) 21.9% Evangelicals in Chiapas face prejudice, harassment, expulsion from their villages, attacks against their churches and private property, threats of sexual assault, imprisonment and murder. Opposition to evangelicals derives mostly from their refusal to participate in community religious events that involve pagan rituals and heavy drinking. Evangelicals are considered a threat to local political and religious leaders' control.
