ABLE TO SAVE FOR ALL TIME

Hebrews 7:1-28 (*But We See Jesus #8*)

- ◆ Melchizedek, who precedes Aaron, gives a glimpse of God's plan through His Son. (7:1-3, 4-10)
- ◆ The Lord's indestructible life proves His law exceeds the old. (7:11-14, 15-19)
- ◆ The new priesthood supersedes the old because of God's oath, plus the permanence and character of Jesus. (7:20-22, 23-25, 26-28; Psalm 2:7; 110:4)

Who will bring any charge against those whom God has chosen? It is God who justifies. Who is he that condemns? Christ Jesus, who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us. Romans 8:33-34 (NIV)

NEXT STEPS: Gather with another. Take turns reading through Hebrews 7 aloud slowly. On what word or phrase does your attention rest? Why? Review the outline. Read through the hymns: *He Is Able to Deliver Thee* and *Once for All*. For how much of you did Jesus die? How much of you does He have? Share His next step for you. How will you encourage each other this week? Who needs to hear about what you know of Jesus? Pray for each other. (For extra study read through Genesis 14, Psalm 2 and Psalm 110.) Prepare for worship next week by reading Hebrews 8.
