Joel (*Minor Faith, Major Problems #2*)

- ◆ The LORD will use things not good to drive us to Himself Repent. (1:15; 2:1-2; 2:11)

Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as sons. . . God disciplines us for our good, that we may share in his holiness. Hebrews 12:10b (cf. 10:11; Romans 8:28)

Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity. Joel 2:13

- ◆ The LORD will pour out His Spirit on all. Call on His name. (2:27-32)

“Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call.” Acts 2:38-39 (cf. 2:16, 22, 36-37; Romans 10:8-17)

- ◆ The LORD will gather all for a final day. Pray for His coming. (cf. 3:14, 18, 21b)

Review the outline (and, perhaps, the message online). Discuss with another how God is calling you to respond to each of the message points. Who will you tell about Jesus? Pray for each other that you will listen first, then apply the good news where appropriate.

- ***BHUTAN**— Buddhist 74.6%; Christian 2.1%
 Christians may practice their faith in private, but public worship and evangelism are limited. Only Buddhist religious texts are allowed in the country. Non-Buddhist houses of worship and meetings are forbidden. Christians are denied state benefits such as free education, access to electricity and water, health care and employment. Converts face loss of citizenship.
- ***CONFLICTS** in **Ukraine, Syria, Egypt, Central African Republic, South Sudan**
- ***NIGERIAN** girls being held as hostages
