***LAOS** - 57.3% Buddhist; 3.4% Christian.
 This tiny, isolated country neighbors Vietnam, China, and Burma. As one of the few remaining communist nations, Laos is a volatile area for Christians. Officially, the government permits the practice of four religions, including Christianity. In reality, however, Christians are harassed, evicted from their homes and forcibly relocated, denied education opportunities, arrested, and forced to deny their faith. Churches are watched carefully by the government.
