## THE KING, THE SHEPHERD, THE SON

Zechariah 9:9; 13:7; 12:10; Mark 14:26-31 (Necessary Suffering #3)

- ◆ Welcome the King Who came and is coming!

*"The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until tribute comes to him; and to him shall be the obedience of the peoples. Binding his foal to the vine and his donkey's colt to the choice vine, he has washed his garments in wine and his vesture in the blood of grapes."* Genesis 49:10-11 (Read Matthew 21:1-11; Zechariah 9:9-10.)

- ◆ Don't let your failure cause you to forget our Shepherd, our Hope.

Read Mark 14:26-31; Zechariah 13:7, 9.

*"On that day there shall be a fountain opened for the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and uncleanness."* Zechariah 13:1

## Around the World

### Ethiopia - 34% Islam; 60.1% Christian

Ethiopia is Africa's oldest independent country and has the second largest population. It is also one of the poorest nations in the world. Ethiopia was reclassified from "hostile" to "monitored" this year. Though there is a large Muslim population, the Islamic extremism affecting other African nations is not as widespread in Ethiopia. Attacks against Christians by radical groups are rare in Ethiopia, but one believer was killed in a church attack in October.
