Baptism is our personal, public statement of God's saving grace from sin, that Jesus alone is our Lord and Savior.

- ◆ We follow Jesus' example (Matthew 3:13-17), His command (Matthew 28:18-20) and the practice of the first followers of Jesus (Acts 2:41; 8:36-38; 9:18; 10:43, 47-49; 16:31-34; 18:8; etc.).
- ◆ We identify with Jesus in His death, burial and resurrection (Colossians 2:12; Romans 6:3-7)
- ◆ We identify with each other as family, members of His body (1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 4:4-6).
- ◆ We pledge to live together for Christ (Romans 6:4; 1 Peter 3:21) in the power of the Holy Spirit.

As we share with Lori, Mark, Joan, Jon, Dar, Laura, Annika and Logan, let's consider three words: Remembrance, Celebration, Commitment.

Baptism is the work of the Holy Spirit, bringing us to Christ and, hence, a sign of our receiving the Spirit.

Baptism is a sign of moving . . . from death to life . . . from sin and self to Christ and community.

Baptism is a picture of the Gospel, God's grace at work in us . . . past, present and future.

Baptism is both personal and public, the decision of the individual to identify with Christ and His body.

**NEXT STEPS:** Review the notes and Scriptures above. Read through Romans 6:1-14 several times. How is baptism remembrance, celebration and commitment? Share with another. What is the Spirit prompting as your next step? Pray together.
