- ***QATAR** – Muslim 88.4%; Christian 5.9%
Expatriate believers are allowed to practice their faith openly, but Qatari Christians risk arrest or worse. Merely causing a Qatari to doubt his or her faith is punishable by several years imprisonment. Christians are treated as second-class citizens. Criticism of the Muslim faith or the ruling family is a crime. Several Qatari believers have come to the Lord outside the country and have suffered upon their return to Qatar.
