Around the World

UZBEKISTAN— Muslim 84.9%; Christian 0.8%

Though a secular state, Uzbekistan's religious law bans unregistered religious activity. The government relentlessly persecuted the church, especially active congregations. In the southeast, police have campaigned to prevent children from attending worship services. More than 14 different government agencies monitor religious activity. Uzbekistan's secret police carry out phone taps and surveillance on places of worship, occasionally recruiting informers to infiltrate church activities.
