WANTED: INNOCENT VOUNTEER

Isaiah 53:7-9 (*Mission Implausible #4*)

◆ No voice (53:7)

The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole person, sets the whole course of his life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell. James 4:6 (cf. vs. 8)

When he was accused by the chief priests and the elders, he gave no answer. Then Pilate asked him, "Don't you hear the testimony they are bringing against you?" But Jesus made no reply, not even to a single charge—to the great amazement of the governor. Matthew 27:12-14 (cf. Mark 15:5; John 19:9; 1:29)

When Herod (Antipas) saw Jesus, he was greatly pleased, because for a long time he had been wanting to see him. From what he had heard about him, he hoped to see him perform some miracle. He plied him with many questions, but Jesus gave him no answer. Luke 23:8-9

◆ No vindication (53:8)

Now the passage of the Scripture that he was reading was this: "Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter and like a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he opens not his mouth. In his humiliation justice was denied him. Who can describe his generation? For his life is take away from the earth." And the eunuch said to Philip, "About whom, I ask you, does the prophet say this, about himself or about someone else?" Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with this Scripture he told him the good news about Jesus. Acts 8:32-35 (cf. vss. 26-31)

◆ No violence or deceit (53:9; cf. Matthew 27:57-60)

For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without spot or blemish. 1 Peter 1:18-19

To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps. "He committed no sin, and no deceit was found in his mouth." 1 Peter 2:21-22

NEXT STEPS: Read Isaiah 53:7-9 several times. What stands out? Memorize 53:7. Review the outline and other texts. How is this good news? Share with another. How is the Lord prompting you to "follow in his steps"? Pray for each other.

Around the World

***KYRGYZSTAN** - 88.7% Muslim; 5.3% Christian

The constitution guarantees religious freedom, but converting to Christianity is seen as a betrayal of both ethnic identity and family. Laws promise to uphold religious freedom, but these laws are not always practiced. Believers regularly face property destruction, intimidation and physical harm. A 2009 Religion Law includes a ban on proselytism and the distribution of religious literature. Religious groups are required to reregister for legal status; churches must now include more than 200 adult Kyrgyz citizens (previously only ten were required). Officials have said they will close churches in an effort to pacify the Muslim majority. A Protestant church was closed in 2014 after it was alleged that their 14-year church ownership was "void" due to a contract issue.
