From the Pastor
Living generously begins with a simplicity of heart, a sincerity, a purity. Those concepts all are found in a single word and are translated as such in various passages (cf. Romans 12:8; 2 Corinthians 8:2; 9:11, 13; 11:3; Ephesians 6:5; Colossians 3:22; Matthew 6:22; Luke 11:34; James 1:5).

Would others characterize my life as being generous, generous with the time, talents and treasure God has entrusted? More importantly, would God characterize my life this way?

The good news is that I don't have to do it. I simply (generously, genuinely, purely) let the Holy Spirit within live out His way, instead of binding myself to the flesh and its selfishness. Generosity changes me. It changes others.

My prayer is that our look at this topic in recent weeks has impacted your heart. What if generosity were as important to you and me as prayer or studying God's word? I'm not suggesting we substitute one for the other, but to recognize that **true spiritual devotion/growth is also measured in a move toward simple generosity.** Simply living generously.

Discuss with others (friends, family, small group) what generosity looks like. Where do you see generosity in each other? In what area do you personally struggle most? How can you encourage each other to simply live generously?

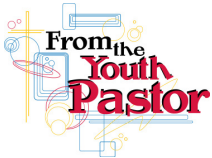

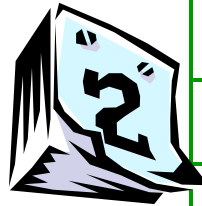
