## HELP!

Hebrews 4:14-5:10 (*But We See Jesus* #5)

*Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make atoning sacrifice for the sins of the people. For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.*

Hebrews 2:17-18

- ◆ Jesus understands our need.

*For our sake he (God) made him (Christ) to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.* 2 Corinthians 5:21

- ◆ Jesus is appointed by God to help us.

### Around the World

\***Morocco**- 99% Muslim; <1% Christian

Though all citizens are considered Muslim, Christian leaders estimate that at least 4,000 attend secret house churches. Conversion is not illegal, but converts can be prosecuted for "shaking the beliefs" of a Muslim and be imprisoned for up to three years. Those who are found guilty of proselytism can also face criminal punishment or expulsion from the country.
