## THE REST OF THE STORY

Ruth 4:13-22 (*Real Love #5*)

- ◆ Speak words of blessing.

*Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit (give grace to) those who listen. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Ephesians 4:29-32*

*Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. Deuteronomy 6:4-5*

*"Love him as yourself, for you were aliens in Egypt. I am the LORD your God." Leviticus 19:34b*

*This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. 1 John 4:10*

- ◆ Praise the Lord for His Redeemer.

*For he (the Father) has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. Colossians 1:13-14 (cf. Ephesians 1:3-10)*

**\*SYRIA**— Muslim 90.0%; Christian 6.3%

During the ongoing civil war there have been many serious human rights abuses, including kidnapping, torture, sexual abuse and summary executions. Christians have been targeted for kidnapping, and their personal property has been attacked and stolen. Christian evangelism is not welcome; missionaries are not allowed in the country. The government closely monitors all activities deemed a threat to communal harmony, and most churches in Syria are hesitant to evangelize Muslims.
