Jeff and Sonya Kilmartin - Cameroon



For the past eight years, the Kilmartins have fostered a connection with the Fulbe people, a nomadic group in West Africa. They are now planning to return to West Africa to work at the seminary in Ndu, Cameroon, though they will also travel and minister among the Fulbe in Cameroon and Nigeria. **Pray** for the ongoing process of learning the Fulfulde language so they will more easily be able to communicate directly with the Fulbe people they interact with. **Ask God** to provide the financial support they need to leave for Cameroon.

Morocco - 99.6% Islam; 0.2% Christian
 Though all citizens are considered Muslim, estimates say there are 4,000 or more Christians who regularly attend secret house churches. Converts from Islam can be prosecuted for "shaking the beliefs" of a Muslim and sentenced to prison for up to three years. Those found guilty of proselytism or converting others also face criminal punishment or expulsion from the country.
