SAVED TO LIVE

Titus 3:3-8 (*This We Believe* #9)

◆ The Father's grace. (cf. 3:4, 5, 7)

The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. Psalm 103:8

For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son. John 3:16a (cf. Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:10)

For by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8-9

◆ The Spirit's work.

He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior. Titus 3:5b-6 (cf. Matthew 19:28; 1 Peter 1:3, 23; John 3:3, 7)

◆ The Son's gift.

Jesus Christ gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good. Titus 2:14 (cf. 3:7)

7 Words to Describe Salvation (cf. *Foundations Participant's Guide*, pp. 112-115)

Substitution: Jesus died in my place.

Justification: Jesus made me right with God.

Reconciliation: Jesus made peace with God possible.

Adoption: Jesus made me a part of God's family.

Redemption: Jesus purchased my salvation with his blood.

Propitiation: Jesus satisfied God's justice.

Forgiveness: Jesus sent my sins away from me.

For we are his workmanship (poem), created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10

NEXT STEPS: Review the outline, scriptures and the NAB Statement of Beliefs #5. Discuss with another what stands out most to you. What are the implications of God's salvation for you, for this world, for those who reject His gift? Have you received God's gift of salvation? Why/why not? If you have, how are you living today as God's beloved child in Christ? *Thank you Father for Your grace, Holy Spirit for Your work and Jesus for Your gift.*

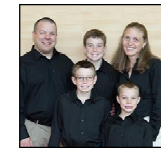
