Hebrews 6:13-20 (*But We See Jesus #7*)

The hope we have in Jesus is anchored in . . .

- ◆ God's promise backed by His word. (6:13-15)

Read Genesis 22; Romans 4:3, 16; Galatians 3:6-9; James 2:21-24.

Think about a challenge you are currently facing. Is God's promise enough for you? Why or why not?

- ◆ God's purpose based in His unchangeable character. (6:16-17)

Read John 8:39; Matthew 5:37.

- ◆ Holding fast to the One Who holds us. (6:18-20; cf. 6:11; 3:6, 14)

NEXT STEPS: Review the outline and scripture texts. Read through Hebrews 6:13-20 aloud three times slowly. Share with another what word or phrase seems to be for you right now. What point in the outline is especially meaningful? Spend some time reading and singing the following hymns: *How Firm a Foundation*, *My Hope Is in the Lord*, *The Solid Rock*, *My Anchor Holds* and *We Have an Anchor*. Pray together after sharing a request and praise. Prepare for worship next Sunday by reading Genesis 14 and Hebrews 7:1-14.

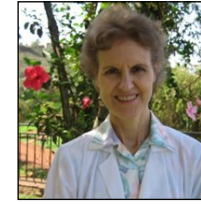
