1 John 1:1-4 (*Real Community #1*)

- We experience the Word of life.

*Always be prepared to give a reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, keeping a clear conscience . . . 1 Peter 3:15b-16a*

How do I experience the Word of life?

- We proclaim the Word of life.

To whom will I proclaim the Word of life?

- We fellowship with the Word of life and each other .

Why is fellowship with the Word of life necessary to have fellowship with others? Why is fellowship with others necessary if I say I have fellowship with God?

- We have joy to the full when we have the Word of life in common with others.

What does joy look like?

**\*TANZANIA**— Muslim 31.2%; Christian 54%  
There is increasing conflict in the Muslim community between moderate and extremists, the latter pressing for the establishment of separate Islamic courts. Witchcraft and superstition are widespread and permeate both Christianity and Islam. The region that was previously Zanzibar remains a tense area. Islamists have attacked dozens of churches and church leaders. Converts to Christianity in Zanzibar face beatings, family rejection, possible imprisonment and even death.
