### AROUND THE NAB CONFERENCE



#### Kristi TenClay - Cameroon

Kristi has been serving in Cameroon since 2010, where she teaches missionary kids and international students at Rain Forest International School in Yaoundé. For the past two years, Cameroon has been in the midst of political unrest. Yaoundé, being the capital, is one of the safer areas of the country, which means families have relocated there to escape the unrest. Both missionary families and Cameroonian families have applied to have their children attend the school. This influx has created a few gaps that have so far been covered by volunteers. Pray for additional teachers because of the increase in the number of students but also due to a number who are nearing retirement age. Keep the nation of Cameroon in your prayers as well.

### AROUND THE WORLD

#### Central African Republic - 76.37% Christians; 32.2% Evangelicals

While the CAR boasts a Christian majority, there is a significant Muslim minority, particularly in the northeast. The militant Seleka group has mobilized formerly marginalized Muslims to fight against the anti-Balaka militant group comprised of animists and nominal Christians. This conflict has been a source of persecution for Christians who face attacks mainly from the Seleka, but also from the anti-Balaka. Pray with persecuted believers to know God's peace and provision in the midst of earthly chaos and loss of possessions.

**AFRICAN WATER PROJECT:** TBC will be raising funds for the Orisai Village in Africa where drought is a common problem and the people suffer needlessly from a lack of access to clean water and proper sanitation. Our goal is to raise \$22,000 and we have a match of \$10,000. We are setting November 25th as our deadline. For more information on this project, contact Bernie Satrom.
