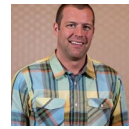

Around the World

***COTE D'IVOIRE** (Ivory Coast) - 41.8% Muslim; 33.6% Christian
A crisis following the November 2010 elections left 3,000 dead, with attacks carried out along political, ethnic and religious lines. 15 Christian pastors were killed, and numerous churches were burned by Muslim extremists. (An earlier internal conflict resulted in a growing religious demarcation: Muslims in the north and Christians in the south.) Many Muslims think they lack adequate representation in government, which has led to growing tensions between Christians and Muslims.
