## TWO FEASTS

Proverbs 9:1-18 (Real Life #9)

Memory verse: *The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.* 9:10

- ◆ Choose Wisdom → Life (9:1-6)
- ◆ Refuse to debate the cynical and proud. (9:7-9)

*A mocker resents correction; he will not consult the wise.* Proverbs 15:12

- ◆ Recognize Wisdom's Source. (9:10-12)
- ◆ Choose Folly → Death (9:13-18)

*By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a short time.* Hebrews 11:24-25 (cf. Genesis 38-39)

*"Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost. Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not satisfy? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and your soul will delight in the richest of fare. Give ear and come to me; hear me, that your soul may live.* Isaiah 55:1-3a

## Around the World

\***CUBA** - 25.0% non-Religious; 56.5% Christian

While fewer Christians have been imprisoned for their faith in recent years, the Cuban government still arrests, mistreats, marginalizes and openly opposes Christians. Children are required to renounce Christ and embrace communism in school; Christian young people are not allowed to graduate from high school or enter a university. The Religious Affairs Office attempts to control churches through surveillance, infiltration and harassment of church leaders. Access to Bibles is greatly limited. Cuban law prohibits the unauthorized assembly of more than 12 people, so many Christians meet in unregistered house churches.
